

Floyd and Nancy Miller Scholarship Prospectus

1. Purpose

The scholarship's purpose is to recognize and assist outstanding in-coming freshmen who need financial assistance in order to attend Santa Clara High School. A renewable scholarship distributed over four years will be awarded to help defray the cost of tuition.

2. Eligibility

Applicants shall be U.S. citizens in good academic standing and must be graduates of Santa Clara Elementary School.

3. Application

A written statement of no less than one full page describing the applicant's reason for wanting to attend Santa Clara High School and explaining what they will bring to the school must be submitted no later than May 20, 2008. One letter of recommendation must accompany the statement.

(12 pt. type, double spaced, .5 margins)

4. The Award

A selection committee consisting of family members of Floyd and Nancy Miller shall review and consider all qualified applications and recommend candidates for final decisions. The committee will award one four-year scholarship and will reserve the right to cancel the award in the event that the student is unable to maintain a 2.5 GPA or better.

The award will be disbursed in equal payments of \$812.50 annually for four years.

Taxes, if any, shall be the responsibility of the student's family.

The Miller family reserves the right to amend this announcement without notice; however, any amendments shall not prejudice current or renewing applicants who may receive a scholarship under this program based on the criteria given in this announcement.
